- Provide parents with three or more teaching events in several areas of academics to help parents support their student at home.
- Distribute our monthly newsletter featuring what students are learning in class so parents can participate.

- Provide ongoing opportunities for parents to meet and share experiences and decisions relating to the education of their children.
- Explain curriculum and assessments forms and share performance results and interpret data with data chats and using many forms of collection.
